
Summer holidays

In the absence of free school meals and parents struggling with reduced income or childcare costs, the summer can be a difficult time.

We are hoping to help some families by providing some additional supplies that help children take part in normal summer activities including going on a picnic, having a barbeque or friends round for a sleepover. Bags of food will be packed and delivered in time to get to schools for delivery before the end of term and to do this, we need your help.

We are collecting the following items. They need to be at the foodbank by the 30th June, but can be donated through our usual collection points or at the foodbank. If you are a company who would like to organize a collection, we can provide posters and arrange to pick up. Alternatively, if you would like to donate to help cover any food shortfalls costs you can do so here.

End of year review

A few numbers to show how your support has helped people in crisis in our community. In 2018/19 The foodbank received 35.8 tonnes of food including 14.5 tonnes form the permanent collection points the supermarkets, 5 tonnes from manned supermarket collections and 4.1 tonnes from Harvest Festival celebrations. enabled us to provide enough food to feed over 4011 people, including 1201 children three days. This was achieved through the distribution of 952 family boxes and 842 single and limited cooking designed for people managing without cooking facilities.

We also supplied 465 bags of toiletries, 178 cleaning packs, 110 laundry supplies, 81 bags of nappies, 44 bags of baby food, 88 welcome packs, containing crockery, cutlery, cooking pans, towels and other basics for when people move out of supported accommodation or rehoused in an emergency and don't have access to basic kitchen items.

We are very grateful for all your donations it makes a huge difference to people as they get back on their feet.
