Knowing that local children are likely to be affected by food insecurity, social isolation and loneliness through the long summer holiday we piloted a summer bag scheme with some of the goodies needed for kids to be able to enjoy a picnic, BBQ and have some treats to share so a friend could come round for tea or sleepover. Bags were designed by a group from Farleigh school and with the help and support of yourselves, and a fun Juniper June Jolly, we were able to distribute 144 bags in time for the holiday. One school reported that parents were almost in tears by this generosity, so we would like to pass on their thanks.

#### Tin Can Cook

We were lucky to be a beneficiary of several copies of Jack Monroe's Tin Can Cook books which we have been distributing across our network. Designed with people cooking on a really tight budget or from foodbank supplies as Jack herself has done, this inspiring book gives tasty recipes taking into account not only the cost of the food but also of the cooking. We are delighted that we have been able to share this resource with some of our clients and agencies.

## Supermarket collections

Supermarket collections are a vital source of food for foodbanks and they also give us a chance to speak to you, answer any questions, pass on immediate needs or update with numbers. We sometimes have the pleasure of seeing people we have helped in the past, and it's great when they stop by and say hello.
