

Harvest 2022

The Andover foodbank helps individuals and families in crisis by providing emergency food boxes. Food for these boxes is donated by local schools, churches, individuals, groups and companies.

Care professionals give those in need a food voucher, which they can exchange for a box at one of the distribution points. This is a short-term measure allowing some breathing space while professional help is provided to try and resolve their longer-term issues.

- Last year, over 6000 people were fed via emergency boxes distributed from Andover foodbank, 1873 were children
- Last year an amazing 56,000 tonnes of food was donated
- We work with a network of over 60 agencies including Schools, Citizens Advice, Children's Social Services, King Arthurs Hall, Health Visitors and Andover Young Carers
- In addition to food, we distribute toiletries, cleaning and laundry products, nappies and market vouchers for fresh produce

Andover foodbank provides help to people across the Test Valley, from Andover to Stockbridge, Ludgershall to Whitchurch.

June is usually one of our quietest months, but as increasing inflation and energy bills pushes more people into financial insecurity it became our second busiest month since we opened in 2006.

Our busiest time of year for supplying food boxes is the run up to Christmas and in January. The harvest collections are very important in helping to meet this need.
