

Harvest 2026

Andover Foodbank supports individuals and families in our community who are struggling to afford food and other essentials by providing emergency food parcels. Food is donated by local schools, churches, groups, individuals and businesses, and we also purchase additional food and essential items when needed.

People are referred to us by care professionals and receive a voucher for a food parcel. We also offer access to Citizens Advice, helping people understand their financial situation and access any support they may be entitled to. Our aim is to provide immediate help while supporting people towards a future where they no longer need a foodbank.

So far this year we have supported 4775 people in our community, that's over 42,000 meals. In addition to food we give out toiletries, cleaning, baby and pet food and essentials. We also give a market voucher and eggs to everyone who collects a food box.

We fund a Citizens Advice caseworker who is at the Foodbank every day and advises more than 20 people a week reducing their dependency on the Foodbank.

We work with a network of over 60 agencies including schools, Citizens Advice, Adult and Children's Social Services, Aster Living and Finding Freedom.

We now run our Foodbanks in community hubs across Andover and Ludgershall, making it easier for people to access emergency food and support closer to home.

Our busiest time is the run up to Christmas and donations can drop in January and February. Harvest collections are very important in providing food for this period and in to next year.
